13th ANNUAL R/M YOUTH HANDICAP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **Certification/Management:** This tournament is certified through the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) and rules not covered on this form are governed by the USBC rules and regulations. Tournament Director and the Board of Directors of R/M USBC Association will decide any questions not covered by these rules or USBC Tournament Rules. Tournament Director and the Board have the power to hear and act on all protests (rule 12 below) concerning the tournament. Their decision is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule #329.
2. **Eligibility:** All Youth members of the Rowan/Mooresville USBC Association are eligible to enter. If not a current member of the Rowan/Mooresville USBC Association, but a current USBC member, participation is allowed with a \$2.00 Association processing fee. If not a current USBC member, a full membership may be purchased for \$6.00. If needed, send in properly completed USBC Membership card with entry form.
3. **Tournament Event:** This tournament shall consist of a Team, Doubles and Singles events. The Team event shall consist of four (4) bowlers. The ****Doubles/Singles Events - If entering either, both must be entered.** The Doubles Event will consist of two (2) bowlers. The tournament will be classified as indicated based on the bowlers' average.
4. **Entering Average:** Bowlers entering average will be determined in the following order, Review USBC Rule 319a for 10 pin and other average rules that will apply to this tournament.
 - a) The bowler's highest USBC Yearbook average for the 2017/2018 Fall/Winter seasons (based on a minimum of 21 games).
 - b) The bowlers highest USBC Average for current season as of Mar 1, 2019. **Submit League Standing sheet with entry form or bring latest League Standing sheet with latest recap to tournament, if not current.*
 - c) The bowler will bowl scratch with a 230 average (No Handicap).

NOTE: As a Member of USBC, you are responsible for abiding by all USBC Rules. According to USBC Rule 16a, it is each bowler's responsibility to determine that the submitted average is correct. Failure to use the correct average may result in disqualification. All bowlers must initial recap sheet next to average before bowling.

5. **Fees:** All fees must accompany entry. Make all money orders or checks payable to the R/M USBC Association. Personal checks accepted, \$35 check fee on all returned checks. **Optional Scratch events and All Events are per person*
6. **Prize/Awards Money:** Awards will be given in the following order - **\$125 Singles, \$250 Doubles, and \$500 Team.** Scholarships will be awarded for the following accomplishments based on entries (We will match entries in each category up to \$100):
 - High All Events Handicap
 - High All Events Scratch
7. **Bowler Handicap:** **Handicap is 100% of the difference of the bowlers entering average and 230.**
8. **Bowler Tardiness:** Any bowler or team arriving late will be allowed to bowl and the score(s) will count beginning in the frame being bowled. **A SCORE OF ZERO IS GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.** Substitutions will be allowed. Team Captains must report any changes 45 minutes prior to squad time to the tournament director. Teams must check in 30 minutes before squad time.
9. *When bowlers are scheduled alone on a pair of lanes, they must bowl as though they were actually contested. The bowlers' complete one frame on one lane before the lead-off bowler commences the next frame on the adjoining lane.*
10. **Dress Code/Etiquette:** Bowlers are expected to wear suitable attire. Bowlers are expected to conduct themselves appropriately and be ready to bowl when it is their time to bowl.
11. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 48 hours of completion of the tournament. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director within 24 hours of the close of the tournament.
